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children's literature isn't just for children anymore this original study explores the varied forms and roles of children's literature when it's written for adults what do Adam Mansbach's go the f k to sleep and Barbara Park's ma there's nothing to do here have in common these large format picture books are decidedly intended for parents rather than children in No Kids Allowed Michelle Ann Abate examines a constellation of books that form a paradoxical new genre children's literature for adults distinguishing these books from YA and middle grade fiction that appeals to adult readers Abate argues that there is something unique about this phenomenon principally defined by its form and audience children's literature Abate demonstrates engages with more than mere nostalgia when recast for grown up readers Abate examines

how board books coloring books bedtime stories and series detective fiction written and published specifically for adults question the boundaries of genre and challenge the assumption that adulthood and childhood are mutually exclusive

anthony burgess and america is a biographical and critical analysis of burgess s commentary on and relationship with the united states of america utilising burgess s entire canon and newly discovered materials to assess burgess s views on america this book also evaluates the american inspirations in five burgess novels this essential addition to burgess scholarship tells the story of a nearly unexplored area of burgess s life for the first time ever burgess s american experiences work and documented communication lectures interviews and public utterances are brought together to assess where these commentaries overlapped with his fiction the result is a complex personal and public history about one of britain s greatest twentieth century authors and their immersion into and interaction with american culture in the second half of the twentieth century

between 1867 and 2000 the canadian government sent over 150 000 aboriginal children to residential schools across the country government officials and missionaries agreed that in order to civilize and christianize aboriginal children it was necessary to separate them from their parents and their home communities for children life in these schools was lonely and alien discipline was harsh and daily life was highly regimented aboriginal languages and cultures were denigrated and suppressed education and technical training too often gave way to the drudgery of doing the chores necessary to make the schools self sustaining child neglect was institutionalized and the lack of supervision created situations where students were prey to sexual and physical abusers legal action by the schools former students led to the creation of the truth and reconciliation commission of canada in 2008 the product of over six years of research the commission s final report outlines the history and legacy of the schools and charts a pathway towards reconciliation canada s residential schools the métis experience focuses on an often overlooked element of canada s residential school history canada s residential school system was a partnership between the federal government and the churches since the churches wished to convert as many aboriginal children as possible they had no objection to admitting métis children at saint paul des métis in alberta roman catholic missionaries established a residential school specifically for métis children in the early twentieth century while the anglicans opened hostels for métis children in the yukon in the 1920s and the 1950s the federal government policy on providing schooling to métis children was subject to constant change it viewed the métis as members of the dangerous classes whom the residential schools were intended to civilize and assimilate this view led to the adoption of policies that allowed for the admission of métis children at various times however from a jurisdictional perspective the federal

government believed that the responsibility for educating and assimilating métis people lay with provincial and territorial governments when this view dominated indian agents were often instructed to remove métis children from residential schools because provincial and territorial governments were reluctant to provide services to métis people many métis parents who wished to see their children educated in schools had no option but to try to have them accepted into a residential school as provincial governments slowly began to provide increased educational services to métis students after the second world war métis children lived in residences and residential schools that were either run or funded by provincial governments as this volume demonstrates the métis experience of residential schooling in canada is long and complex involving not only the federal government and the churches but provincial and territorial governments much remains to be done to identify and redress the impact that these schools had on métis children their families and their community

seals and their context in the middle ages offers an extensive overview of approaches to and the potential of sigillography as well as introducing a wider readership to the range interest and artistry of medieval seals seals were used throughout medieval society in a wide range of contexts royal governmental ecclesiastical legal in trade and commerce and on an individual and personal level the fourteen papers presented here which originate from a conference held in aberystwyth in april 2012 focus primarily on british material but there is also useful reference to continental europe the volume is divided into three sections looking at the history and use of seals as symbols and representations of power and prestige in a variety of institutional dynastic and individual contexts their role in law and legal practice and aspects of their manufacture sources and artistic attributes importantly and distinctively the volume moves beyond the study of high status seals to consider such themes as the social and economic status of seal makers the nature and meaning including reflections of deliberate wit and boastfulness of specific motifs employed at various levels of society and the distribution of seals in relation to the location of for instance religious institutions and along major routeways in so doing it sets out ways in which sigillography can open new pathways into the study of non elites and their cultures in medieval society
